TORONTO, ONTARIO--(January 12, 2010) - Chariot Resources Limited (TSX:CHD) announced that the public hearing of the Mina Justa Environmental and Social Impact Assessment ("ESIA") review process was held Friday January 8th, 2010 in San Juan de Marcona.

David Brownrigg General Manager of Marcobre SAC (70% owned by Chariot Resources) who attended the meeting, noted that several questions began with a compliment, stating that Marcobre had conducted itself with respect, transparency, and was a true role model in the community. The Ministry took note of the positive community reaction.
